



Summer Camp Counselor Job Posting

**Seasonal daytime hours: Up to 40 hours per week
Pay Range \$9.65 – \$10.50**

Job Summary: Under the direction of the Director of Community Programs and in accordance with the goals and objectives of the Marshall Area YMCA, Counselors are the primary staff working with a group of up to 75 children, responsible for planning activities with the group as well as with other groups during the camp program. In addition he/she is to aid the Marshall Area YMCA in fulfilling our mission to instill the values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility through programs and services that build healthy spirit, mind and body for all. Summer Camp will begin on May 31 and will end August 31. Training week will be early May.

Minimum Qualifications: Position requires a person with experience in camping, or working with younger children. Must be at least 18 years of age. Person must have a personality that reflects a love of children, can understand and meet their wide variety of needs, and is creative and spontaneous. CPR and First Aid certifications are required (may be obtained upon being hired).

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Incumbent must be able to move easily across a variety of indoor and outdoor terrain; participate in typical outdoor children's games, sports and activities; watch and listen to the activities of a group of children; lift up to 50 pounds; and spend up to eight hours per day outside in a variety of summer weather conditions.
